Chapter 2, p. 38, question 2.96: The case should read as follows:

A 59-year-old patient with past medical history of chronic heart failure, hypertension, and hypertriglyceridemia is suffering from **cervical** disc herniation at **C2–C3** and **C4–C5**. The surgeon decided to perform arthrodesis using an interbody technique. Then the patient was brought to the OR after general anesthesia and standard preparation. The physician performed anterior arthrodesis with morselized iliac bone graft harvested through a separate incision, and anterior instrumentation (**C2–C5**) was done. How should these services be reported?
